## Alberta, Nunavut, \& NWT Admission at a Glance

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Step One: Apply for admission at www.uregina.ca/admissions/apply.html (or for Nursing at www.sasknursingdegree.ca) and pay the $\$ 100$ application fee.

Step Two: Submit a transcript to Enrolment Services by March 15, 2024 (or for Nursing to Sask Polytechnic by March 15, 2024) to meet the Early Application Deadline.

Step Three: Check to ensure that you are registered in the courses you need for Final Admission (see reverse), and complete these courses by June 30, 2024
Step Four: Submit your Final Official Transcript from your province's official online portal, after graduation, by August 1, 2024.

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## FINAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS BY FACULTY

FACULTY AVERAGE REQUIRED
Arts - 70\%
Applicants with an average between 60-69.99\% will be admitted to the Arts Qualifying Year. Economics major requires Math 30-1 or Math 30-2 with a minimum grade of $70 \%$.

## Education-65\%

All Education programs are competitive entry.
Elementary Education requires one 30-level Math course (excluding Math 31).
Secondary Education major or minor in Math requires Math 30-1.
Secondary Education major or minor in Physics requires Math 30-1 and Physics 30
Secondary Education major or minor in Chemistry requires Math 30-1, Chemistry 30, and Physics 30
Joint BMus/BMusEd program requires an interview, music theory test, and audition.

## Kinesiology \& Health Studies (Health Studies ONLY) - 70\%

## Media, Art, \& Performance - 65\%

BFA \& CFA programs in Visual Arts or Indigenous Art require a portfolio
Joint BMus/BEd \& BMus programs require an interview, music theory test, and audition.
Social Work (U of R Pre-SW or FNUniv Indigenous SW Qualifying) - 70\%

## Business Administration - 70\%

Applicants missing a required English or Math course, but with an average of $70 \%$ on the remaining required courses, may be admitted with a Qualifying Status.

Engineering \& Applied Science - 90\% (Major of Choice) or 70\% (General Systems)

Applicants will be admitted as an Engineering Qualifying student if they are missing one subject that is used for Final Admission, but still have an average of $70 \%$ on the remaining four courses.

## Kinesiology \& Health Studies - 70\%

Bachelor of Kinesiology (all majors) requires Math 30-1 and one of Biology 30, Chemistry 30, or Physics 30.

Applicants will be admitted as a Kinesiology Qualifying student if:
(a) missing one of the subjects used for Final Admission, and/or
(b) have an admission average that is between 65-69.99\%.

## Nursing - $70 \%$ (in each course)

Nursing is a competitive entry program.

## Science-70\%

Applicants will be admitted as a Science Qualifying student if they are either:
(a) missing one of the subjects used for Final Admission, but have an admission average o $70 \%$ on the remaining four courses, or
(b) have an admission average between 65-69.99\%, but have all of the five subjects required.
