Rediscovering the Path is a Cultural and Traditional Advisors forum that is open to the public. Visiting Advisors from southern Saskatchewan share their personal insight, cultural, and traditional experiences, preserving Aboriginal oral history.

Advisor Glen Anaquod from the Muscowpetung First Nation and Advisor Sylvia Obey from the Piapot First Nation work at the Aboriginal Student Centre providing cultural and traditional support to students. Forums were initiated to preserve oral history and give students the support from the traditional community.

Rediscovering the Path forums are recorded by staff and students of the Indian Communication Arts department at First Nations University of Canada. All recordings are available for personal use and can be purchased by donation.

- Thursday, February 11th:
