When I worked at the Regina Open Door Society I enabled a refugee family volunteer at a downtown centre. To make this possible and to create a meaningful experience for the volunteering individuals and the organization they volunteered with, we had to address barriers such as language, communication style, prejudice and fears. The volunteering experience became a reality through joining of many hands that included The Regina Open Door Society, South Saskatchewan Independent Living Centre, and Interpreters. Volunteering at the downtown centre became the first work experience in Canada for this family and led to future opportunities and relationship building for the family.
