Restrictions: Patrick Lane holds the copyright to all material. There are restrictions on various files.

Scope and content: The Patrick Lane Fonds consists of correspondence, writings, publications, photographs, and records of the professional activities and the personal relationships of Patrick Lane. The fonds has been arranged into 14 series: Correspondence, Financial Records, Personal, Photographs, Professional Activities, Professional Associations, Publications about Patrick Lane, Publications of Others, Writings by Patrick Lane, Writings by Patrick Lane and Lorna Crozier, Writings about Others, Writings by Others, Red Lane and Audio-Visual Materials.

### Biographical sketch:

Name: Patrick Lane. His parents were Albert and Elaine Lane. He had three brothers Dick (deceased), John, and Michael and one sister named Linda. His first marriage was to Mary Hayden. They had three children; Chris, Mark, and Kate. He divorced Mary and married Carol Beale. They had two children; Michael and Richard. He began a relationship with writer Lorna Crozier in the late 70s.

Place of residence: Patrick Lane was born in Nelson, British Columbia on March 26, 1939. In his earlier adult years, Lane travelled and worked around many areas of British Columbia. However, in relation to this collection, there were five cities in Canada that were his prominant place of residence; Edmonton, Montreal, Regina, Saskatoon, and Toronto.

Occupation, life, and activities: From the late 1960s to the present day Patrick Lane's primary occupation has been that of poet and writer. In 1978 he won the Governor General's Award for Poetry for his book Poems, New and Selected (1978). Throughout his writing career he has won numerous other awards. He has published over sixteen books of poetry, one children's book, and he has been featured in several anthologies. Patrick Lane has also been employed as a writer-in-residence in various educational institutions and libraries across Canada. He has also conducted many writing seminars and workshops.
