Scope and Content:

This fonds consists of 3.8 meters of material.

The fonds are open for research.

The scope of these fonds is from 1987 - 1994.

The fonds consist of material generated by Maggie Siggins in the research and writing of two books: <u>Revenge of the Land: a Century of Greed, Tragedy and</u> <u>Murder on a Saskatchewan Farm</u> published by McClelland and Stewart in 1991 and <u>Riel: a Life of Revolution</u> published by Harper Collins.

The <u>Revenge of the Land:...</u> series consists of excerpts from books, historical papers and documents, court documents, homestead documents, interviews (transcribed and original recordings), newspaper and magazine articles and photographs. All of these document the history and settlers of Section 11, Township 16, Range 25, west of the Second Meridian near Pasqua, Saskatchewan from 1883 to 1989. Some of the material also related to the people and events occurring in the Moose Jaw area during this period.

The <u>Riel:...</u> series includes excerpts from articles, books, newspapers and legal documents pertaining to Louis Riel's life from 1844 to 1885. These records include documentation relating to the Red River Colony and the Red River Rebellion in Manitoba and the North-West Rebellion of 1884 to 1885 culminating in Riel's death. Also included are materials on the settlement of the Red River Colony; Louis Riel's parents and grandparents; and events occurring in Regina, Prince Albert and the Batoche area during the North-West Rebellion; and translations, from French to English, of poetry and letters by and to Louis Riel.

Biographical Sketch: Maggie (Marjorie) May Siggins was born May 28, 1942 in Toronto, Ontario. She is the daughter of Elizabeth May Siggins. She married Gerald (Gerry) B. Sperling on August 23, 1987. She has 3 children.

Place of Residence: She currently resides in Regina, Saskatchewan.

Education: A Bachelor of Applied Arts in Journalism from Ryerson Polytechnical Institute was received in 1965.

Occupation, life and activities: Maggie Siggins began her journalism career as a Reporter at the <u>Toronto Telegram</u> in 1965. In 1971 she became a political reporter and commentator for CITY-TV, Toronto. Leaving CITY-TV where she worked for CBC Television, Toronto as a reporter, interviewer and producer during 1975 - 77, she returned to produce an hour long night news program, CITYPULSE News, 1979 - 81.

Maggie Siggins has worked as a freelance magazine writer and broadcaster. Her work has appeared in numberous publications including: <u>Chatelaine</u>, <u>MacLean's</u>, <u>Reader's Digest</u>, <u>Financial Post</u>, and <u>Today Magazine</u>. In <u>Toronto</u> <u>Life</u>, 1981 - 1983, she published a monthly political column, and she has produced television documentaries for CBC and CITY. Maggie Siggins spent 1985-86 in Beijing, China, working for the New China News Agency and as a professor of graduate studies at the Beijing Broadcast Institute. She has also taught journalism at the University of Toronto under the Southham Fellowship for Journalists, 1973-74 and at the University of Regina under the Max Bell Chair in Journalism, 1983-84.

Siggins has published numerous non-fiction books: <u>A Guide to Skiiing in Eastern</u> <u>Canada</u>, 1969; <u>How to Catch a Man</u> with cartoonist Ben Wicks, 1970; <u>Bassett:</u> <u>His Forty Years in Politics, Publishing, Business and Sports</u>, 1979; <u>Brian and the</u> <u>Boys: A Study in Gang Rape</u>, 1984; <u>A Canadian Tragedy</u>: <u>JoAnn and Colin</u> <u>Thatcher. A Study of Love and Hate</u>, 1984; <u>Revenge of the Land: A Century of</u> <u>Greed, Tragedy and Murder on a Saskatchewan Farm</u>, 1991 and <u>Louis Riel: A</u> <u>Life of Revolution</u>, 1994.

<u>A Canadian Tragedy:...</u> was produced into a 4 hour mini-series by CBC Television and aired in December 1989. It was re-aired on NBC in the United States in July 1990, the BBC in England in 1991 and forty other countries. A mini-series of <u>Revenge of the Land:...</u> is currently in production by CBC Television. A French translation of <u>Riel:...</u> is to be published by Editions Quebec-Amerique, Montreal in the spring of 1996. A member of the Writers' Union of Canada she is serving as its Chair in 1995-96. She holds memberships in the following professional organizations:

Saskatchewan Writers' Guild, Canadian Historical Association, Alliance of Canadian Television and Radio Artists, Canadian Association of Journalists and Saskatchewan Motion Picture Association (ACTRA). In 1995-96 she is also Board Member of Poets, Playwrights, Editors, Essayists and Novelists (P.E.N.). She has participated as a member of the Board of Directors for NeWest Press in Edmonton, Alberta and Curtain Raisers Players in Regina, Saskatchewan.

In 1985 Siggins won the Crime Writers of Canada Arthur Ellis Award for <u>A</u> <u>Canadian Tragedy:...</u>. <u>Revenge of the Land:...</u> was awarded the Governor-General's Literary Award for Nonfiction in 1992. In 1994 <u>Riel:...</u> won the City of Regina, Best Book Award.

Besides English she is fluent in Mandarin Chinese and literate in French.
