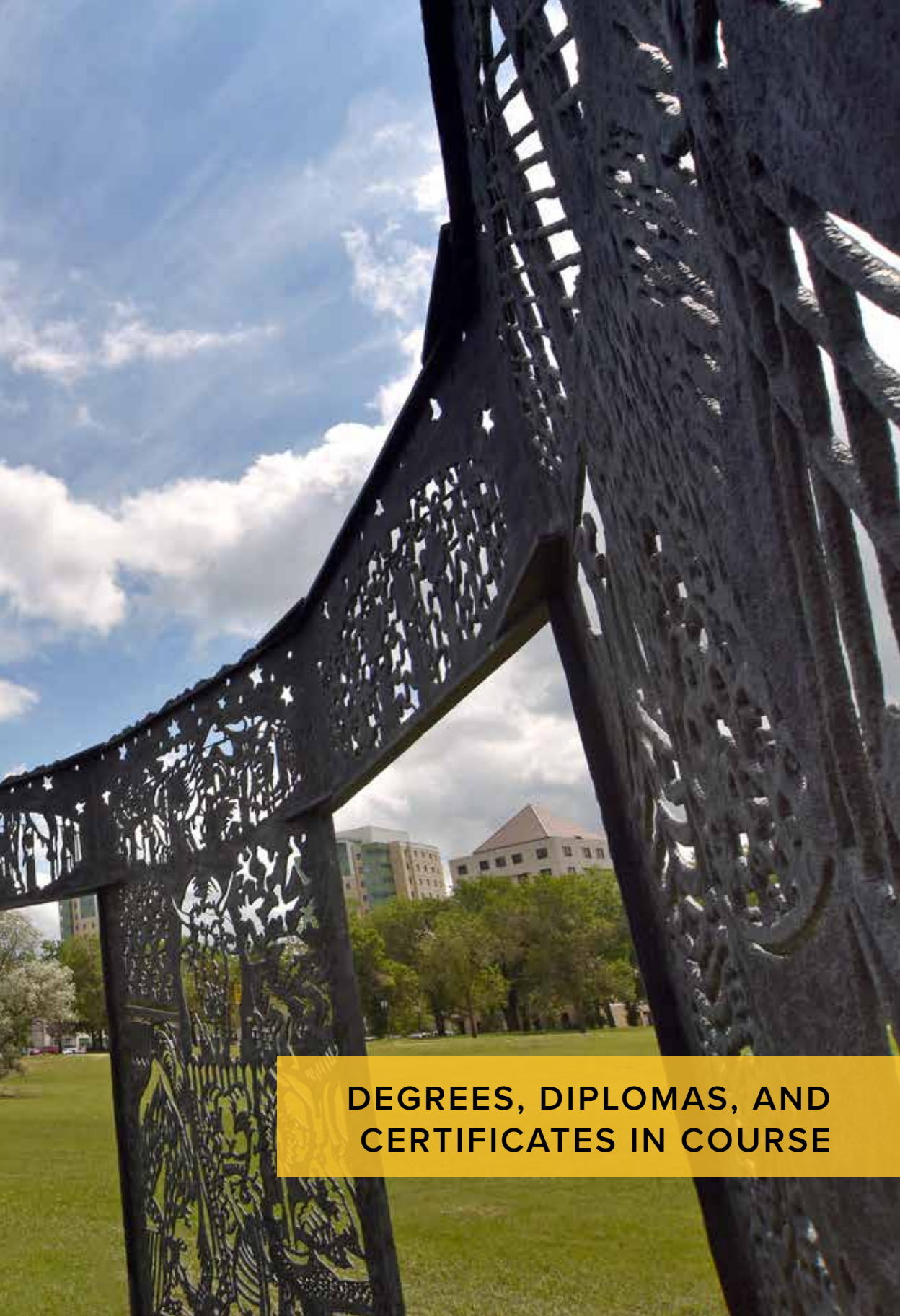
Total surprise was Gary Drummond's reaction when he first learned he would be the recipient of a University of Regina honorary degree. As one of the most successful business people in the province's history there is no denying his qualifications.

Drummond was one of the founding partners of Direct Energy in the late 1980s and since that time he has successfully led businesses in real estate, farming, ethanol production, brew pubs and tap houses, a string of oil and gas companies, an electricity and natural gas marketing company, a smart meter supplier, a security firm, and an upscale hotel in Kelowna. He also practiced commercial law for 18 years and served four years as the president of hockey operations for the NHL's Arizona Coyotes.

Drummond credits the success that he's had to what he learned in university, particularly about focusing, prioritizing and building long-term relationships. A post-secondary education does not guarantee health or happiness, he says, but it is a foundational building block to a creative and successful career, and, generally, a better life.

"It is much more difficult without a post-secondary education to achieve that level of success, and so I feel that the grads receiving their degrees from the U of R are very fortunate, and will have opportunities open up to them, as they did for me," says Drummond. "Having a university in a community certainly opens up paths for individuals, and contributes to the overall well-being of the community."

STUDENT AWARDS AND UNIVERSITY TRADITIONS

UNIVERSITY OF REGINA PRESIDENT'S DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE STUDENT AWARD

The University of Regina President's Distinguished Graduate Student Award is awarded at Fall Convocation to the most distinguished student at the Master's or Doctoral level who has defended theses, or completed final exhibitions or performances, and is graduating at either the spring or fall convocation ceremony.

Dr. Kenneth Clayton Wilson, PhD, Media & Artistic Research

Kenneth Wilson's research during his Doctoral program focused on Indigenous ways of knowing and being through a settler's perspective on relationships to land and place. This inventive research required Dr. Wilson to spend two years learning basic Cree as he worked on his research. During his doctoral research, Dr. Wilson authored seven refereed journal articles, one book Chapter, and two poems. His nonfiction essay "populous" was short-listed for the Constance Rooke Prize for Creative Nonfiction. In addition, the artistic work *Walking the Bypass: A Meditation on Place*, which accompanied Dr. Wilson's thesis, won the City of Regina Writing Award. Dr. Wilson has presented his work at numerous national and international conferences, mobilizing his research to benefit and educate communities.

UNIVERSITY OF REGINA PRESIDENT'S MEDAL, FACULTY OF MEDIA, ART, AND PERFORMANCE DEAN'S MEDAL, AND UNIVERSITY PRIZE IN MEDIA, ART, AND PERFORMANCE

The University of Regina President's Medal is awarded at each Spring and Fall Convocation to a student receiving a first undergraduate degree who has shown academic excellence as well as significant leadership and commitment to extra-curricular activities while a student at the University.

Sage Victoria Helen Michelle Wosminity, Bachelor of Arts in Media, Art, and Performance *with Great Distinction*

Sage is graduating with an 86.80% undergraduate grade point average. Since 2019, she has received scholarships based on academic excellence and artistic merit and was named to the Dean's Honours list multiple times. Sage is not only an accomplished artist and scholar, she worked throughout her studies at the University of Regina. She worked and curated an exhibition at Neutral Ground Artist Run Center. Sage also completed a professional placement as a curatorial intern with the University of Regina's Dr. John Archer Library, where she assisted with the President's Art Collection and the Campus Art Guide. Sage's artwork was exhibited in the Fifth Parallel Gallery at the University of Regina. She is passionate about sharing history and culture and she hopes to integrate art and therapy as she pursues a degree in Psychology.

Sage is also the recipient of the Faculty of Media, Art, and Performance Dean's Medal, which is presented to a student graduating with a first degree who has demonstrated both leadership and academic achievement in the Faculty of Media, Art, and Performance. UNIVERSITY PRIZE IN ARTS

The University Prize in Arts is awarded to the most distinguished graduate in the Faculty of Arts receiving a first degree.

Ashley Jean King, Bachelor of Arts in Psychology, *with Great Distinction*

Ashley began studying at Campion College at the University of Regina in the fall of 2019 and immediately demonstrated an aptitude for academics. With a term average consistently over 90%, Ashley was named to the Dean's Honour List every term and earned several scholarships over the years.

FACULTY OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION DEAN'S MEDAL

The Faculty of Business Administration Dean's Medal is awarded at each spring and fall Convocation to a student receiving a first degree with a minimum average of 80% who has shown leadership in and commitment to extra-curricular activities while at the University of Regina.

Taylor Catherine Jane Eltom, Bachelor of Business Administration, General Business Studies, *with Distinction*

Throughout her university career, Taylor's active role in extra-curricular activities has demonstrated a strong commitment to improving the community's well-being, specifically those most vulnerable. She is a founding member of the *University Of Regina Champions Of Change Club* that engaged in community fridge donations and classroom talks. These initiatives included receiving grants to provide food to members of our community. She is the Social Media Coordinator of *Inside the Box SK*, which promotes mental health and well-being in athletics. Taylor is also on the Youth Advocacy Panel Member of *RaiseHER Community*, which supports the advancement of women into leadership roles. Taylor excelled academically, graduating with a grade point average of 82.21%, and was named to the Dean's Honour List in the winter and fall of 2022 and winter of 2023.

UNIVERSITY PRIZE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The University Prize in Business Administration is awarded to the most distinguished graduate in the Faculty of Business Administration receiving a first degree.

The Saskatchewan Teacher's Federation (STF) Award is given to the most distinguished graduate in the Faculty of Education who does not hold another degree.

Tyson Wesley Reader-Delorme, Bachelor of Education, English Education, *with Distinction*

Tyson was diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy after birth. He credits the diagnosis alongside the work of his mother, educators, the Wascana Rehabilitation Centre, and Music For Young Children programmes as factors behind his holistic development and decision to pursue a career supporting persons with disabilities.

Tyson ascribes his passion for individualized learning and advocacy for inclusion to his mother's lived experience with chronic illness and an Acquired Brain Injury (Chiari Malformation). He states: "Keeping an informed, open mind, having a kind, compassionate heart, and being both persistent and adaptable in the face of adversity are the values I hope to instill in the coming generations of change-makers."

Tyson plans to continue his education with hopes of pursuing further study and a career centred on addressing the psychological, behavioural, and emotional needs of learners with disabilities and the de-stigmatization of disability.

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING AND APPLIED SCIENCE DEAN'S MEDAL AND UNIVERSITY PRIZE IN ENGINEERING AND APPLIED SCIENCE

The Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science Dean's Medal is presented at each Convocation to recognize the achievements of an outstanding student in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science.

Darsh Patel, Bachelor of Applied Science, Industrial Systems Engineering, *with Great Distinction*, Co-operative Education

Samantha is graduating with a cumulative grade point average of 86.86%.

Throughout her academic career, Samantha has consistently demonstrated her strong work ethic and dedication to her studies. A recipient of the University of Regina Entrance Scholarship, she also received the Academic Silver Scholarships in fall of 2021 and 2022, and was named to the Dean's Honour List in the winter and fall of 2021 and 2022.

Hailey remains passionate about advocacy and hopes to complete a master's in social work in the future.



ACADEMIC REGALIA


















At live Convocation ceremonies, the academic regalia worn by the graduates and the members of the platform procession may consist of a gown, a hood or stole (worn over the shoulders), and a hat or mortarboard. All universities have distinctive academic dress for each degree conferred and, at times, for the disciplines in which the degree is awarded.



With the exception of students graduating with a PhD and federated college students, graduates wear black gowns. PhD graduates' gowns are scarlet with royal blue around the collar, down the front and around the sleeves.

Students graduating from the University of Regina who have been registered through a federated college wear the following: red gowns for Campion College students, sky blue gowns for First Nations University of Canada students, and royal blue gowns for Luther College students. Students are welcome to wear their Indigenous ceremonial dress, other cultural ceremonial dress, or their military or law enforcement dress uniform with, or instead of, the gown at the Convocation ceremonies.

CEREMONIAL FURNITURE

The three ceremonial chairs were a gift to the University of Regina from Dr. Terence R. McKague, Chancellor Emeritus, who served as Chancellor from 1989-1995. The chairs were acquired from Carmichael United Church, Dr. McKague's boyhood place of worship. This ceremonial furniture is incorporated into all official ceremonial functions.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE UNIVERSITY

The University of Regina is situated on Treaty 4 lands with a presence in Treaty 6 territory. These are the territories of the nêhiyawak (Cree), Anihšīnapek (Saulteaux), and Dakota, Lakota, and Nakoda, and the homeland of the Métis/Michif Nation. Today, these lands continue to be the shared territory of many diverse peoples from near and far.

The University of Regina operates under the terms of *The University of Regina Act*. Convocation comprises the Chancellor, the Senate, all graduates of the University of Regina, all graduates of the University of Saskatchewan at Regina Campus, and such other classes of persons as the Senate may from time to time determine. Convocation meets twice annually, in June and October, unless there are extraordinary circumstances.

The Chancellor is elected by the members of Senate, holds office for three years, presides over Convocation, confers degrees and is *ex officio* Chair of the Senate and a member of the Board of Governors.

Senate is the University's "window on the world." It is concerned with the academic welfare of the institution and has a variety of duties and powers. Most of the broader issues of academic policy within the University are reserved for Senate's approval. In another role, it acts as an ultimate court in academic affairs. The membership of Senate includes

persons *ex officio*, or by virtue of the University offices they hold. Convocation elects another fourteen members of Convocation to the Senate. Students registered in the University elect six students of the University to Senate. In addition, any professional society, group or organization in the province that Senate believes contributes in a significant way to the social, economic and cultural welfare of the province may be represented on Senate.

The Board of Governors consists of eleven members and is responsible for overseeing the administrative and business affairs of the University. It ultimately has authority in matters related to the raising and spending of University funds, and the acquisition and management of University property.

Council's membership includes administrative officers, all Deans and directors of academic programs, all full-time members of the teaching staff, and a number of student representatives. All matters of substance related to the academic affairs of the University, as well as matters of academic discipline, must be considered and approved by the Council.

The Executive of the University of Regina Council (Executive of Council) has been empowered by Council to act on its behalf. Executive of Council membership is devised as a proportional basis of the academic composition of the University.

Disciplines that are related to one another in the broader areas of teaching are, for purposes of administrative and academic planning, brought together into Faculties, of which there are currently ten. Each Faculty is headed by a Dean; formal membership includes the Dean and the teaching members of the various associated disciplines. The Deans are recognized by *The University of Regina Act* as being the heads of their respective Faculties and are directly responsible to the President through the Provost and Vice-President (Academic). Subject to the statutes of the Senate and the University of Regina Council, each Faculty has charge of all matters of scholarship in its disciplines and programs.
