Early Conditional & Final Admission Process Current Domestic High School Students

Step One: Apply for admission at www.uregina.ca/admissions/apply.html (or for Nursing at www.sasknursingdegree.ca) and pay the \$100 application fee.

Step Two: Submit a transcript to Enrolment Services by March 15, 2024 (or for Nursing to Sask Polytechnic by March 15, 2024) to meet the Early Application Deadline.

Step Three: Check to ensure that you are registered in the courses you need for Final Admission (see reverse), and complete these courses by June 30, 2024.

Step Four: Submit your Final Official Transcript from the BC Ministry of Education or the Yukon high school that you attended, after graduation, by August 1, 2024.
