#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

**Step One:** Apply for admission at <a href="www.uregina.ca/admissions/apply.html">www.uregina.ca/admissions/apply.html</a> (or for Nursing at <a href="www.sasknursingdegree.ca">www.sasknursingdegree.ca</a>) and pay the \$100 application fee.

**Step Two:** Submit a transcript to Enrolment Services by **March 15, 2026** (or for Nursing to Sask Polytechnic by **March 15, 2026**) to meet the Early Application Deadline.

**Step Three:** Check to ensure that you are registered in the courses you need for Final Admission (see reverse), and complete these courses by **June 30, 2026**.

**Step Four:** Submit your Final Official Transcript by **August 1, 2026,** by requesting it from your high school's administrator after graduation.
