

FINAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

FINALIZE YOUR CONDITIONAL ADMISSION FOR FALL 2022

Step One: Check your admission letter to confirm which faculty of study you have been admitted to and then find your faculty in the chart below. You will need to **complete all of the corresponding high school courses** with the minimum overall average required.

Step Two: After graduation, send your Final Official Transcript by contacting the administrative office at your school. This transcript must indicate your graduation date.

Final official high school transcripts must be received by Enrolment Services by August 1, 2022.

Faxes, photocopies, and emailed transcripts from the student are NOT accepted.

Joint Programs	Must Meet Requirements of Both Faculties

- A maximum of two different Math courses can be used in the Admission Calculation.
- ELA can be Comprehensive, Literary, or Transactional Focus.
- The equivalent grade 12-level French language arts subject may also be used.
- Any 40S-level language course not listed may also be used as a Category B course.
- Any 1-credit AP or IB course can be used in the appropriate category.
