

# FINAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

## FINALIZE YOUR CONDITIONAL ADMISSION FOR FALL 2022

**Step One:** Check your admission letter to confirm which faculty of study you have been admitted to and then find your faculty in the chart below. You will need to **complete all of the corresponding high school courses** with the minimum overall average required.

**Step Two:** After graduation, send your official transcript to the Admissions Office. This transcript must indicate your graduation date. Please contact the administrative office of your school for instructions on ordering your transcript.

**Final high school transcripts must be received by Enrolment Services by August 1, 2022.**

Faxes, photocopies, and emailed transcripts from students are NOT accepted.
