

# FINAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

## FINALIZE YOUR CONDITIONAL ADMISSION FOR FALL 2022

**Step One:** Check your admission letter to confirm which faculty of study you have been admitted to and then find your faculty in the chart below. You will need to **complete all of the corresponding high school courses** with the minimum overall average required.

**Step Two:** Transcripts can be requested at any time in your Grade 12 year, to be sent after June exams are complete. Transcripts are sent electronically to the U of R by the ministry in mid-July. Requests are made here: [www.k12.gov.sk.ca/etranscript/](http://www.k12.gov.sk.ca/etranscript/).

**Final official high school transcripts must be received by Enrolment Services by August 1, 2022.**

Faxes, photocopies, and emailed transcripts from the student are NOT accepted.

Bachelor of Kinesiology (all majors)	Pre-Calculus 30 and One of Biology 30, Chemistry 30, or Physics 30
BFA & CFA In Visual Arts/Indigenous Fine Arts	Portfolio
Economics Major	Foundations of Math 30, or Pre-Calc 30, with a Min Grade of 70%
Elementary Education	One 30-level Math Course (excluding Calculus 30)
Joint BMus/BEEd & BMus	Interview, Music Theory Test, Audition
Joint Programs	Must Meet Requirements of Both Faculties
Secondary Ed, Major or Minor in Math or Physics / Secondary Ed, Major or Minor in Chemistry	Pre-Calculus 30 / Pre-Calculus 30, Chemistry 30, Physics 30

### NOTES

- A maximum of two different Math courses can be used in the Admission Calculation.
- Fransaskois/Immersion students may use one of Français fransaskois A30/B30 or Français Immersion 30 course in combination with either one of the ELA courses.
- Only one of Band 30, Choral 30, or Music 30 can be used.
- Only one of Exercise Science 30 or Physical Education 30 can be used.
- Any 30-level language course not listed may also be used as a Category B course.
