

Suggested Academic Plan for ECON Co-op Students

Before the work term students need to have successfully completed ENGL 100 and one of: ENGL 110; PHIL 100; RLST 245, 248; SOST 110 and at least two ECON courses; need to have completed at least 45 credit hours (including the semester in which you are applying into the program); and have a minimum PGPA of 67.5%. **The Department of Economics HIGHLY RECOMMENDS the completion of ECON 201, 202, 224, and 280 before the first work term.**

YEAR 2 Summer	Work Term I: Before this work term, students need to have successfully completed ENGL 100 and 110, two ECON courses; have completed at least 48 credit hours, and have a minimum PGPA of 70%. The Department of Economics HIGHLY RECOMMENDS the completion of ECON 201, 202, 224, and 280* before the first work term.	
YEAR 3	ECON 301; ECON 310 ECON course	Work Term II: The Department of Economics HIGHLY RECOMMENDS the completion of ECON 301, 302, before the second work term.

YEAR 4	Work Term III	ECON 307 ECON321 ECON 480 under targeted supervision
