## Department of Psychology Policy on the Submission of Honours Theses

Once an Honours thesis is complete, the supervisor will submit a PDF copy of the final thesis to the Department of Psychology (<u>Psychology.Dept@uregina.ca</u>).

Supervisors must also get their students to complete and sign the "oURspace Institutional Repository License Agreement for University of Regina Students." In signing this document, students are giving permission for their theses to be added to the library's online thesis repository. This repository is searchable through the University's oURspace system; this system is also accessible through Google Scholar searches. As such, supervisors should ensure that their students understand that their theses will be accessible to anyone, but that they are protected by copyright.

Once the thesis and the completed License Agreement form have been submitted to the Department, the supervisor will next submit a grade on DOME for the student's PSYC 400AB mark. It is at the supervisor's discretion to determine which components this grade is based on and how they will be weighted. Components may include, but are not limited to: the thesis itself, the symposium presentation, activities performed throughout the completion of the project (e.g., participant recruitment and testing; data scoring and analysis), and the student's skills and attributes (professionalism, independence, commitment, etc.).
