What You'll Do:

- Assist with ongoing project examining youths' conceptualization of confidence using rigorous, quantitative research methods to inform best practices in legal contexts
- Develop skills in quantitative research, interview-based data coding, and applied work with children.
- Research ethics training for work with children
- Gain insight into potential career paths in academia and psychology research.

To Be Eligible:

- Interns must be able to commit up to 8 hours per week during a 13-week semester, working for an organization;
- Have a declared major in a Faculty of Arts program (NOT including Health Studies, Human Justice or Journalism, because they have their own internship programs);
- Have completed between 54 - 90 credit hours (negotiable) at the end of the semester in which you are applying, which MUST include at least 12 credit hours in your major;
- Have a satisfactory academic standing, with a program GPA of at least 70%
