### **What You'll Do:**

- Assist with knowledge mobilization for a national research project around climate change and climate justice currently in its final stages, including academic publications, reports, and creative outputs
- Develop skills in research knowledge mobilization, writing policy briefs, and analyzing qualitative data
- Network with community organizations, students, and researchers from across Canada
- Gain insight into potential career paths in academic research and policy writing.

### **To Be Eligible:**

- Interns must be able to commit up to 8 hours per week during a 13-week semester, working for an organization;
- Have a declared major in a Faculty of Arts program (NOT including Health Studies, Human Justice or Journalism, because they have their own internship programs);
- Have completed between 54 - 90 credit hours (negotiable) at the end of the semester in which you are applying, which MUST include at least 12 credit hours in your major;
- Have a satisfactory academic standing, with a program GPA of at least 70%
