Four Hill students including Drew Broadfoot, Brock Forbes, Drayton Leflar and April Pyne, placed third in the Montreal Exchange Options Trading Simulation contest. For the contest teams were given a virtual cash account of \$100,000 to build their options portfolios and had to execute 5 separate strategies over an 8 week period.

April, Brock and Drayton are members of the UR Investing team which they attribute much of their knowledge to. Their background knowledge from following the markets daily paired with the knowledge learned in class helped them to exe-

The Preliminary Round of the competition has

students complete а business case analysis. Students have one month to complete their analysis and submit their written recommendation. The cases are then reviewed and the top five or six finalists in each category are selected and invited to the Final Round at School Queen's of Business in Kingston, Ontario. The Final Round

takes place over two days during which students have 5.5 hours to analyze and prepare a business case to present to a panel of judges.

The 2016 finals will be held at Queen's University January 14 to 16th.


The Levene School will partner with Edwards,
