ICBC is an international case competition that sees students complete a written business case analysis in the preliminary round, with submissions taking place in the fall. Submissions are reviewed and the top five or six finalists in each category are selected and invited to the final round at Queen's in Kingston, Ontario. The Final Round takes place over two days where students have 5.5 hours to analyze
