Bob Anderson is one of the world’s leading scholars in the area of entrepreneurship research, and in particular, community entrepreneurship and indigenous peoples’ entrepreneurship. He has shaped the direction of international research in his field and is recognized as an international authority. He has an enviable record of publications, conference presentations, and research grants. His publications include four books, over forty papers in peer-reviewed publications, and well over 100 peer-reviewed conference presentations. Dr. Anderson is known as a superb mentor, and his guidance and collaboration are sought after by researchers and doctoral students from around the world. Dr. Anderson has also contributed to the Entrepreneurship discipline through his work as managing editor of the *Journal of Small Business and Entrepreneurship* and as co-editor of the *Journal of Aboriginal Economic Development* and the *Journal of Enterprising Communities: People and Places in the Global Economy*.
