



Michael Doucet was appointed on December 28, 2012 to the position of Executive Director of the Security Intelligence Review Committee (SIRC).

Mr. Doucet joined SIRC from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police where he held the positions of Chief Information Officer (CIO) and Chief Technology Officer.

Prior to joining the RCMP in April 2010, Mr. Doucet occupied the position of CIO/ Director General of the Information Management Services Branch at Correctional Service Canada for over two years. Mr. Doucet has also worked with the Communications Security Establishment of Canada (CSEC) as the CSEC's Senior Liaison Officer to the National Security Agency as well as working with the Canadian Food Inspection Agency.
