### Application Information for UIP 2019

**1. Eligibility:** Full time enrollment as a student at home university, must be returning to home university

**2. Required Documents**

- Application Form, University Transcript
- Copy of Passport in color as PDF
- Passport type photo file – JPG High Quality

**3. Application Deadline:** 9 AM, Friday, March 29 (submit to [Wendy.Tebb@uregina.ca](mailto:Wendy.Tebb@uregina.ca) by email)

**4. Program Period:** July 2(Tue), 2019 ~ July 25 (Thur), 2019

**\* Arrival date: June 28(Fri) ~ July 1(Mon) / Departure date: July 26(Fri) ~ July 28(Sun)**

**5. Korean Tuition is waived for the 2 selected/approved UofR students for 2019.**

**Students will pay UofR tuition for BUS 408AB plus a fee equivalent to \$500 US to cover**
