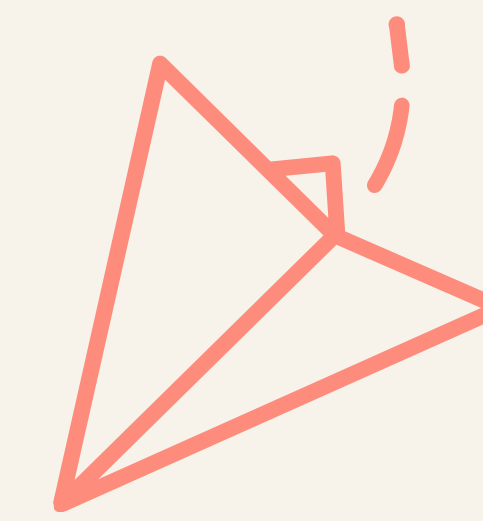

What are we trying to solve?

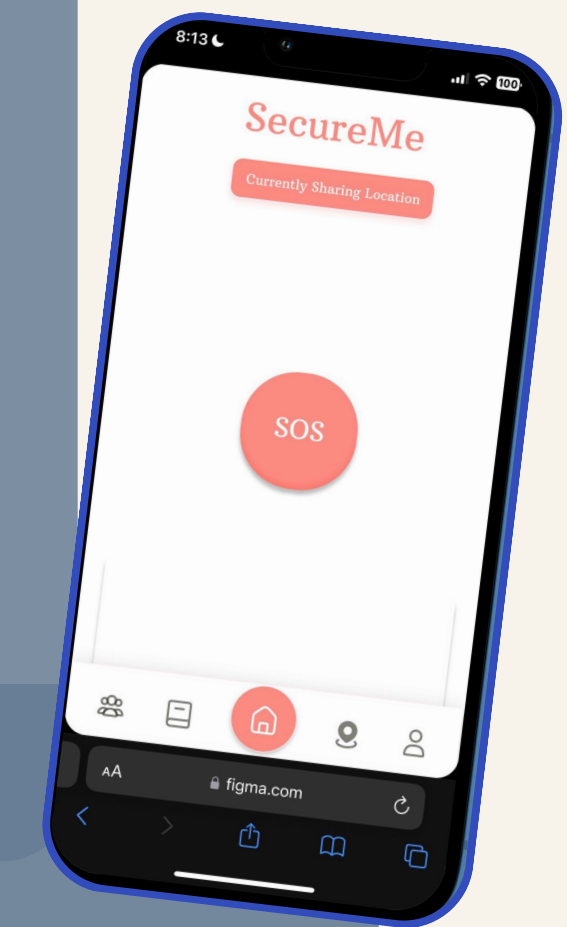
In a world where personal safety should be a basic right, it's disheartening to acknowledge the grim statistics of 2022: Around 184 women and young girls lost their lives to gender-based violence *, and around 129,876 individuals experienced family violence, with 117,093 falling victim to intimate partner violence**.

These statistics aren't just numbers; they represent people we know, love, and their families. It's a reminder that personal safety should not be a privilege, but a fundamental assurance.

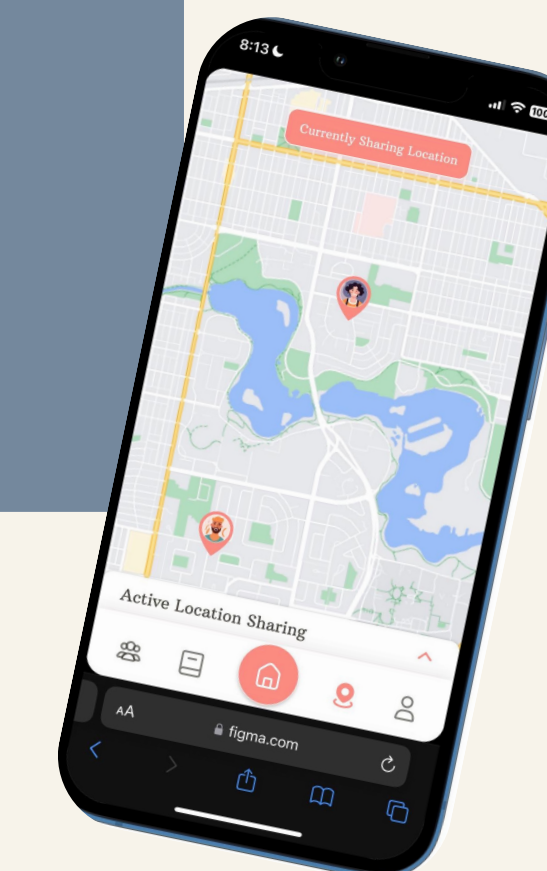
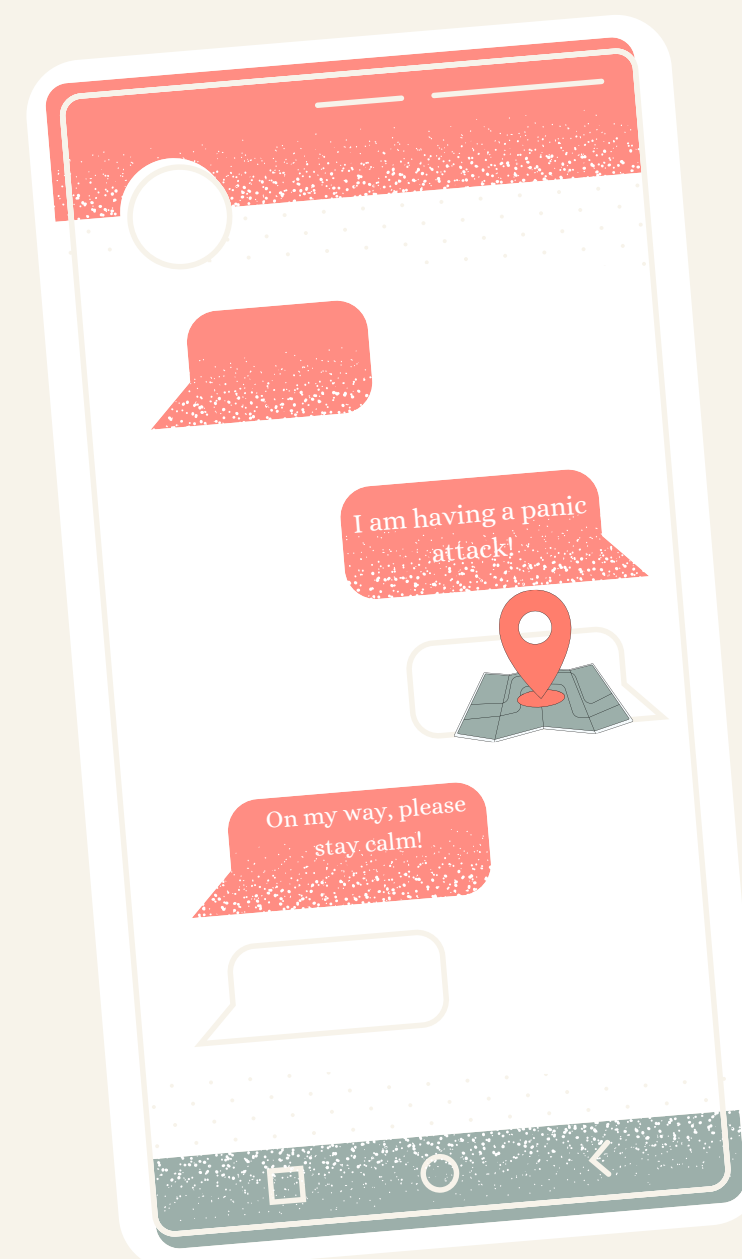
App's Features
