SAFETY MOMENT

Final exams are just around the corner, and the university's holiday closure will be here before we know it! A quick reminder that campus will be open on December 24, but the Faculty of Engineering & Applied Science offices - along with many other faculty and department offices - will be closed. The main campus will then close from December 25 to January 1, reopening on Friday, January 2. (Campus housing stays open throughout the break.)

For everyone's safety and comfort, we encourage you to avoid working on campus during the closure whenever possible. Buildings will be operating with minimal heating and ventilation, so indoor temperatures will be cooler and air circulation very limited. Most campus services, including custodial, purchasing, receiving, and routine safety services will pause for the break. **Protective Services will still be available 24/7** at **306-585-4999**.

If you do need to be on campus - for example, to check on long-term experiments - please:

- Work with your supervisor to identify and manage any risks.

You must have written permission from your supervisor to work during the closure.

Innovation Saskatchewan will be open during the last week of December (except statutory holidays), but because campus resources will be extremely limited, working on campus during this time is not recommended.

Before you head out for the holidays, please take a moment to prepare your labs and offices:

- Remove any food and empty all garbage bins
- Shut down experiments and cooling water systems
- Turn off or unplug small appliances and equipment, where appropriate
- Lower fume hood sashes
- Properly secure chemical and waste containers
- Make sure all gas cylinders are safely secured
- Do one last walkthrough to ensure everything is safe and powered down
