PPE Reminders

For those of you who work in labs with chemicals, please remember to follow PPE (personal protective equipment) requirements at all times. We care about your safety - PPE is essential for that! Requirements should be posted on all lab doors (if yours is missing, please contact Lauren.Bradshaw@uregina.ca). Basic minimum requirements, to be worn before entering the labs and kept on the entire time, include: safety glasses (prescription glasses are not sufficient), long pants, shirts with short or long sleeves, and shoes that fully cover feet. The need for gloves and lab coats depends on your activities. Keep yourself safe - and if you see others without their PPE, advocate for their safety and kindly remind them.

EXIT INSPECTIONS

Are you close to wrapping up your research? Finishing classes? Planning to graduate in the near future? If yes, and you have/had access to labs or office space, please make arrangements with your supervisor to complete your 'exit inspection' and return of keys/cards. This is one of the required steps in FGSR's Checklist for the Submission of a Thesis/Dissertation. It is also required for MENG students who used research labs.

For us (and for your supervisors), this process ensures facilities are left in good condition, safe, and protected from unauthorized access. For YOU, this checklist needs to be completed (and keys returned) to get your deposit returned. This deposit is \$100 for most spaces.
