DEANS HONOUR LIST

The Deans Honours list recognizes academic achievements by graduate students. To be eligible students must have completed all course requirements and have a CGPA of 90% or greater.

Eligible students will be notified by Wendy at the end of each semester.

Note that this does not appear on official transcripts.

GRADUATE RESEARCH SHOWCASE

Did you publish a paper in Spring Summer 2025? If yes, we would like to highlight your accomplishment on the website!

A call will be made for submissions to the research showcase three time a year. Submissions are accepted in May (if you published during Winter term), September (if you published during Spring Summer term) and January (if you published during Fall term).

When you receive the call for submissions, submit your paper for the Research Showcase by filling out the Application Form and submit it via email to Gina.MacPherson@uregina.ca per the timeline above. This website will be updated once per term with all submissions.

MAINTENANCE OF CANDIDACY

Thesis-based students who have completed the credit hour component of their program of studies, but have not completed all of the formal approved degree requirements (e.g. written a thesis and defense) are to register in:

GRST 995AA – Full-time Maintenance of Candidacy

COURSE INFORMATION

Course Outside of the Program (related discipline, extra to the program, or undergraduate classes): Permission must be sought prior to registration in the course and it needs to be relevant to the program. Requests must be sent through UR Self-Service (graduate requests) except for undergraduate courses, contact your advisor for the override.

Required courses that have specific timing:

ENGG 701 – Offered in Winter only and is for MEng students

ENGG 702 – Offered in Spring/Summer only and is for MEng students

ENGG 703 – Offered in Fall only and is for MEng students

ENGG 800 - This course is available only for PhD students and should be registered in 1/2 way through your research credit hours.

ENGG 900 - This course is for Thesis-based students only and is offered in Fall and Winter. It is NOT offered in Spring Summer. This course has a prerequisite of 6 901 hours.

GRST 801 - All new students must complete this no cost tutorial in their first semester.

TA/GTA POSITIONS

GTA/TA payroll letters will be out in early September. Please ensure your current visa letter and registration are complete to ensure you are eligible for a potential job offer. Only selected students will be contacted.

Students can apply through the Career Connect portal at

https://careerconnect.uregina.ca/. Please have your academic supervisor sign the attached form and include it with your application and work permit when you apply. Shortly after submitting your application, your coordinator will be in touch to set up an entrance meeting with you. The meeting will be conducted via MS Teams or in the CESL Office. (Riddell Centre 163) International Student?

If you are an International student and you want to apply for Co-op for Winter 2026, you must already have applied for your co-op work permit and have provided our office proof of your application.

FINANCIAL SERVICES

Students have been notified via their @uregina.ca and preferred email addresses that **tuition** and fees are due on the first day of classes each term.

To remain enrolled in their selected **Winter 2026** classes, students must ensure their student account is either:

- Paid in full, or
- Reduced to a balance under \$2,000

on or before September 29, 2025, unless they have confirmed student financial aid in place.

Key Dates and Impacts:

- October 1, 2025 Late fees applied
- October 2, 2025 Registration holds applied (prevents adding/dropping classes)
- October 27, 2025 Deregistration from Winter 2026 classes

If students do not meet the payment requirement by **September 29**, they will be **deregistered from all Winter 2026 (term 202610) classes**, and their seats will not be held. Students may re-register once their account balance is below \$2,000, but **course availability is not guaranteed**, and they may not be able to return to their original schedule.

Payment Options for Students:

Students can pay their tuition and fees through:

- Online credit card payments
- Internet or telephone banking
- In-person or mail payments
- Flywire (for international students)
- Government student financial assistance

Note: Financial aid funds do not need to be received by September 29, 2025. However, the University must have **confirmed the student's enrolment** with their provincial funding body by that date.

If the student is being **band funded or have a third-party organization** paying their tuition, please ensure they send in a sponsorship form to the college you are registered through and

then the university will invoice them directly after the last day to add and drop classes.
