## **Registration Waitlists (WL)**

Is the class full? Get on the waitlist! They are a first-come-first-served basis. If the class has a lab/seminar you can only be WL'ed for the lecture.

When an open seat becomes available, an e-mail will be sent to your Preferred E-mail Address. Check your preferred e-mail address on a regular basis if you are on a WL. I'd recommend every morning and every night.

If the waitlist notification email is sent prior to the first day of classes, you will have **24 hours to register for the class**. On the first day of classes this is changed to **12 hours to register for the class**. If you missed it, you will have to get back on the WL! Your seat will be offered to the next student. So check your email regularly!

Registration Holds will prevent you from registering in a waitlisted class. Holds will prevent you from registration in *any* class. So, check your holds before registration. You can view your holds in your UR Self-Service account under the 'Student' tab.
