## 12 MONTH INTERNSHIP

The Engineering Co-operative Internship Program is set to begin a new intake of students, with placements commencing in September 2026 for 12 months. We will be accepting applications in March. Applications for Fall 2026 Internship must be made by completing the application form in [Career Connect](#). If you have any questions about the application, please contact the [coop.office@uregina.ca](mailto:coop.office@uregina.ca). Afterwards, a co-op coordinator from the Co-op office will reach out to book an entrance meeting with you.

Eligibility: Completion of Terms 1-7 classes (must complete Term 6 in SS 2026), minimum 72 credit hours, maximum 102 credit hours completed, Term and PGPA no less than 60%.
