



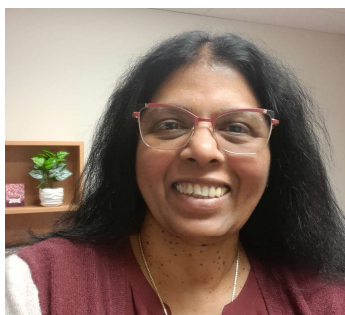
Intercultural Competence is the ability to interact effectively and appropriately across different cultures
