The PDAP will provide faculties/units guidance as well as a discussion forum, creating efficiency in the approval process.

- To undertake specific reviews including making recommendations concerning continuance, modification, or discontinuance of existing programs at the request of the Council Committee of the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (CCFGSR) or the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research.
- 3. To keep CCAM informed of such graduate program reviews.
- 4. To serve as an advisory body to the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research.

This committee will meet as needed. An annual activity report will be made available to CCFGSR.
