PhD Committee

- **Purpose:** The PhD Committee serves as an Advisory Committee to the Dean of FGSR to provide guidance and support regarding doctoral education at the University of Regina.
- **Membership:** Representative from each Faculty/academic unit offering a PhD program One PhD student representative determined by FGSR in consultation with the GSA
 - Resources: FGSR Associate Dean(s) FGSR Executive Assistant FGSR Faculty Administrator FGSR Manager of Admissions and Registration

Term length: Three years, staggered but student representatives will serve one year.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- 1. Review admission standards for doctoral students.
- 2. Review special case doctoral applications and proposed programs, and recommend admission decisions to the Dean.
- 3. Provide advice to FGSR on doctoral program matters, as requested.

Normally the Committee will be Chaired by the longest serving member and as necessary, the Chair will serve as a member of other University Committees. This committee will meet as needed and report to CCFGSR regularly.
