*NEW*International Applicants

If you are not a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada or protected person under subsection 95(2) of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* (Canada), you must be enrolled in your doctoral program of study at an eligible Canadian institution by the application deadline. Up to 15% of awards across Canada will be available to international applicants.

Transcripts: (VERY IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ IN FULL):

- Please order ALL of your undergrad and graduate official transcripts today and include your up-to-date University of Regina transcripts, even if this is your first semester. Your transcripts must show your Fall registration. This includes any transfer credit also. Please order today, as this process takes time. When you order them, have the transcripts sent electronically, directly to you, as you need to upload all of your own OFFICAL, UP TO DATE transcripts to your own application on ResearchNet.
- If you have international transcripts at this university, please formally request your international transcripts TWO weeks in advance by emailing graduate.studies@uregina.ca for the Request for Transcripts other than University of Regina form. You will need to explain why you require this form. Then once filled in please email the request form to graduate.studies@uregina.ca and copy grad.funding@uregina.ca. Late requests (less than 2 weeks) cannot be granted.
 - *Please use grad.funding@uregina.ca as the email address for all correspondence. **Please be clear in subject line and include your name and ID**.*

Overview: The Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research will receive all applications electronically from the Portal after the deadline date noted above. The Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research will then distribute the complete packages for review to the CIHR Scholarship Selection Committee. Once the selections have been made, the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research will submit the successful applications electronically to CIHR.
