   \*When you order your transcripts, have them sent electronically to you, as you need to upload all of
   your own OFFICIAL, UP TO DATE transcripts to your own application.
- If you have International transcripts at this university, please formally request your international transcripts TWO weeks in advance by emailing graduate.studies@uregina.ca for the Request for Transcripts other than University of Regina form. You will need to explain why you require this form. Please email the transcript request to graduate.studies@uregina.ca and cc: grad.funding@uregina.ca Late requests (less than 2 weeks) cannot be granted so please plan ahead.
