

# What to do when: You Need a WHMIS Label

## When do I need a label?



- Any chemical that is not in an original manufacturer's bottle will need a WHMIS label (NOTE: really old manufacturer labels are not WHMIS compliant either, and need a proper WHMIS label)
- Eg: If you pour some methanol from a 4L manufacturer's bottle into a 1L bottle, you will need a WHMIS label for the 1L bottle
- If you aren't going to be using up the chemical in <24hr, it needs to be labeled
- Your own samples (things you made) need to be labeled with a date, identifier (notebook page number, for example), and your name

## How do I get a label?

- UR Stores has drawers with many different chemical labels already printed, feel free to take what you need!

## Label Paper:

- The labels are printed on brightly coloured yellow paper, so they are easily recognizable
- There are two **sizes** available to choose from
- There are two types of label adhesive: removable and permanent
