# ADMISSION

## ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

*Students applying for a French program or registering for a class must complete the online placement test on [lacite.uregina.ca](http://lacite.uregina.ca).*

### FRENCH AND FRANCOPHONE INTERCULTURAL STUDIES

1. In "Planned Program of Study", select "French & Francophone Intercultural Studies - BA (BachofArts)"
2. Complete the placement test (results will be e-mailed)

*NB: French fluency is not required to enroll in the major*

### FRENCH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE — FULL-TIME PROGRAM (1 YEAR)

1. In "Planned Program of Study," select "French as a Second Language Certificate"
2. Complete the placement test with a score of FRN 101 to FRN 200 (results will be e-mailed)
3. Following the placement test, students will be invited to complete an oral assessment

*NB: Upon completing the Certificate, students may apply for a faculty transfer*

### EDUCATION - LE BAC

1. In "Application Type," select "Baccalauréat en éducation" for the French version of the Teacher Education Application Profile (TEAP)
2. In "Planned Program of Study," under "Programme" select among:
  - a. Bac en éducation secondaire (Secondary Education)
  - b. Bac en éducation élémentaire (Elementary Education)
  - c. Secondary B.Ed - français de base (Core French Secondary Education)
3. Choose among "Other Majors, Minors and Concentrations" (for Secondary Education):  
Biologie (Biology), Chimie (Chemistry), English Education, Français de base (Core French),  
Mathématiques (Mathematics), Sciences générales (Science), Sciences humaines (Social Studies), Éducation  
dramatique (Drama), Éducation inclusive (Inclusive Education), Éducation artistique (Arts Education), Éducation  
physique, (Physical Education)
4. Complete the placement test with a minimum score of FRN 201. Students that place below FRN 201 are encouraged to complete the Certificate in French as a Second Language before applying to Le Bac

### NURSING

1. Apply online at [sasknursingdegree.ca](http://sasknursingdegree.ca) and select "Bilingual Option" for the 4-year program (Regina campus)
2. Complete the placement test with a minimum score of FRN 201 prior to registration

### MINORS

Students must contact La Cité's Academic Advisor after receiving an admission offer to enrol in a minor
