## **SCHOLARSHIPS**, AWARDS & BURSARIES

### **AUTOMATIC ENTRANCE AWARDS**

We have five automatic entrance awards, which are calculated based on the student's early conditional admission average. Students applying directly from a Canadian high school or Canadian Citizens applying direct from a foreign high school would be eligible for the following automatic entrance awards:
