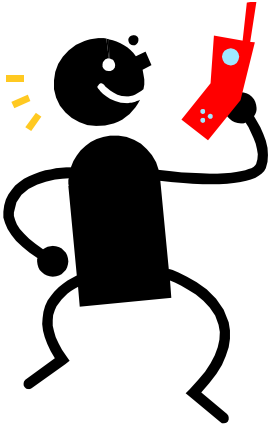

What do I need to do?

- Check in with Campus Security by calling 306-585-4999
- Tell them you will be working alone
- They will ask for your name, and where you will be working
- Call them when you leave to let them know you're done for the day
- You can also ask them to walk you to your car to make sure you get there safely

What is “after-hours”?

- If you are planning to work/study when the University is closed:
 - At night
 - On weekends
 - During holidays



Why is this important?

- You never know what can happen, and if you're working alone, there is no one there to assist you if something goes wrong
- In many cases, it can be crucial to get help right away
- If no one knows you're in the lab, no one will find you until the morning, or worse!
