Health Certificate & Immunizations:

Health Certificate:

- Students may be required to provide a health certificate or medical documentation for their visa/immigration application. This is common with Japan, South Korea, Thailand.
- Please schedule an appointment with your primary care physician or the <u>UofR Student</u> <u>Health Clinic</u>.

<u>Immunizations:</u>

- Some countries and schools may require proof of vaccination/s.
- Please consult your primary care physician and the <u>Government of Canada Travel Advisory</u> for more information on country-specific immunization requirements & recommendations.
- Vaccinations and TB testing can also be completed at the Regina Travel Health Centre.

Travel Health Centre in Regina:

Services Provided:

- Assessment of <u>travel health needs</u> based on travel destination, length of stay, accommodations, activities, and present health status.
- A full range of <u>immunization</u> and assessment for risk of malaria and altitude illness, and provide prescriptions for recommended medications.
