### ***Overview***

- Responsible for all music; pre-game, in-game, and post-game
- Coordinate with Game Day Host, Public Address Announcer, and Showcaller to play music, adjust sound of microphones, and play sounds for promotional timeouts.
- Responsible for equipment including iPad, headset, and sound equipment box.

### ***Requirements***
