

Varsity Sport Student Jobs (Specialized Sport Staff, Gym)

Overview

The University of Regina Athletics is hiring Event Staff to assist at all home games for the Cougars and Rams during the upcoming academic year (Sep. 1, 2026 - February 28, 2027). Event Staff will have the opportunity to work in several venues (on and off-campus), for multiple sports, including Men's and Women's Hockey, Men's and Women's Basketball, Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Women's Volleyball.

Responsibilities

- Staff will be working in several different positions in both Basketball and Volleyball, including Scoresheet keeper, Scoreboard Operator, Wings Operator, Shot Clock Operator and 3-ball workers.
- Scoresheet keepers must meet with coaches prior to the game to note starting players, as well as meet with coaches' post-game to give out scoresheets.
- Scoreboard operators will manage scores of teams, as well as timeouts, fouls, and other pertinent information.
- Wings operator will keep track of which players are in the game, as well as each player's points and fouls.
- Shot clock operators will operate the 24-second basketball clock in accordance with FIBA rules.
- 3-ball workers will run a volleyball movement system to ensure that balls are readily available for the serving team.

Requirements

- **MUST** be a student, registered in classes for both the Fall 2026 and Winter 2027. semesters at the University of Regina. Please provide your student identification number in your application.
- **MUST** be able to work Friday and Saturday evenings, as well as some Sundays. All sports schedules will be posted on cougarsandrams.com.
- **MUST** be fluent in English both written and verbally.
- Knowledge of sports is an asset but is not required.
- **MUST** be able to read a script and understand audio cues.
- **MUST** be available for all game days within the sport you are working (all dates and times will be posted on cougarsandrams.com).
