The Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies at the University of Regina is pleased to announce the opportunity for a graduate assistantship (GA) (Master's or Ph.D. level) in the area of sport and recreation management for the Fall of 2017.

The GA will be assigned responsibility in one of the following areas:

- (a) Communications/sport information (Athletics or Recreation)
- (b) Event marketing/promotion (Athletics or Recreation)
- (c) Graduate teaching responsibility (Graduate teaching fellowship) in the area of sport and recreation management.

Duties and scope of work to be assigned will be based on need and student's area of interest and area of research.

GA positions have the following conditions/constraints:

- a. Normally 8 months in length (Fall and Winter semester)
- b. Require admission into the graduate program in the Faculty (preference given to graduate students in the area of sport and recreation management – thesis based)
- c. Spring/Summer semester opportunities may be also be available
- d. May be extended up to 2 (Masters) or 3 years (Ph.D.)

While somewhat variable, depending on graduate status and nature of the position, GA positions are typically valued between \$14,000 to \$16,000 Cdn.
