Biographical Sketch:

Pamela Wallin was born in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan and raised in Wadena, Saskatchewan. After graduating from Moose Jaw's Central Collegiate Institute, she attended the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus and received a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology and Political Science. Following graduation she worked as a social worker at the Prince Albert Penitentiary. In 1972 she co-hosted a noon-hour, open-line show on CBC Radio in Regina. Wallin spent six years working for CBC Radio in Regina, Ottawa, and Toronto on such programs as "As it Happens" and "Sunday Morning". In 1978 she joined the *Toronto Star* working for the Ottawa bureau. From 1981 to 1984 Wallin co-hosted CTV's "Canada AM". By 1985, she was hired by CTV as the Bureau Chief, making her the first woman in Canadian TV broadcast history to be appointed to this position. In 1992 she became co-host of CBC's "Prime Time News". She was released from "Prime Time News" in April 1995. By the following fall she was hosting "Pamela Wallin Live" on CBC Newsworld, a program that was co-produced by her own production company. By 2002 she had received numerous honorary degrees from various institutions, including a Doctorate of Laws from the University of Regina, a Doctorate of Letters from St. Thomas University, a Doctorate of Laws from Western University, a Doctorate of Journalism from Ryerson Polytechnical University, a Doctorate of Letters from Wilfrid Laurier University, and an honorary degree from Loyalist College.

Scope and content: This collection measures approximately 45cm. The main series are Canadian Television Network (CTV); Clippings; Correspondence; Honorary Certificates; Professional Activities and Publications featuring Pamela Wallin. 8 photographs are included in the collection, _____ of them in the Oversize scrapbooks.

Custodial History: The material in this collection was transferred to Archives and Special Collections by the donor.

Future Accruals: Future accruals are expected.

Access Restrictions: There are no access restrictions in this material.

Related Accessions: 2001-5, 2002-23.

Notes on Arrangement: Clippings from newspapers as well as the pages from two oversize scrapbooks containing photographs were photocopied for Preservation purposes, the donor's original file titles were retained where possible and loose photographs were numbered and sleeved.
