Biographical Sketch: Anne Campbell's writing and community activities kept her in contact with many individuals and organizations, as evidenced in the correspondence files of her papers. The papers have been grouped according to the creator's diversity of interests. Of particular interest are: correspondence files with family, relatives, friends, writers, artists and colleagues; the personal files, professional organizations, publications, and, writings and drafts. The collection provides insights both into Anne Campbell personally, and into the craft of writing and creating poetry in Saskatchewan, and a woman's involvement in the community.

Born in Saskatchewan, Anne Campbell studied at the Regina Conservatory, the University of Regina, and the Saskatchewan School of the Arts. Anne Campbell has published five books of poetry: *No Memory of a Move*, 1983, Longspoon; *Death is an Anxious Mother*, 1986, Thistledown; *Red Earth, Yellow Stone*, 1989, Thistledown; *Angel Wings All Over*, 1994, Thistledown, and *Soul to Touch*, 2009, Hagios. Her poetry has been included in the numerous anthologies and journals. As a Research Fellow at the Canadian Plains Research Centre she co-published non-fiction, including the 2006/2008, award winning, *Regina's Secret Spaces: Love and Lore of Local Geography*. For her writing, Anne Campbell has received a variety of awards; and she has been active on Boards of many professional organizations, including The Writers Union of Canada, the League of Canadian Poets, the Saskatchewan Writers' Guild, the Writers Trust, and the City of Regina and the Wascana Centre Authority Heritage Advisory committees. She has also conducted workshops, and readings across Canada.

Anne Campbell was a long-time member of the management team at the Regina Public Library, initially as Head of Community/Public Relations, and after 1988, responsible for all RPL special community services, including a branch library serving a mainly aboriginal population, literacy services, services to those home-bound, and visually impaired patrons, as well as public relations and community programming. In Calgary she was Community Co-coordinator for Heritage Park, and Head of the Public Information Office for the Glenbow Museum. Previously, in Regina, she was Public Relations Officer and community programmer for the MacKenzie Art Gallery. Earlier she did freelance writing and broadcasting on weekly current and social affairs issue for CBC Radio in Regina, worked as co-organizer of the Three Day Equestrian event at the Western Canada Summer Games and volunteered with the Saskatchewan Association for Children with Learning Disabilities as a workshop coordinator and committee member.
