## REGINA COLLEGE PHOTOGRAPHS AND MEMORABILIA FROM LURLEEN A. (GISH) LOCKWOOD

**Biographical Sketch**: Lurleen Anna Gish was born in 1909, her father worked for the Canadian Pacific Railway Company and after a brief time in Regina the family moved to Kronau. Every Saturday, she took the train to Regina for piano lessons until she started grade 9, when she moved to the city to attend Regina College and later the Normal School.

After Normal School Lurleen taught at Hart S.D. near Coronach and schools in Readlyn and Rabbit Lake. In 1934 she married R.F. Lockwood and the couple farmed at Briarcrest, they moved to Regina in 1943 and then to Moose Jaw in 1961. During the 1950's Merle taught in Moose Jaw and Briarcrest, where she also taught piano and established a junior choir.

Lurleen was a student at the Senior's Education Centre, taking several classes in her retirement. Lurleen especially enjoyed music classes.

**Scope and Content**: The collection relates to Regina College and students, it ranges in dates from 1924 to 1927 and consists of 1 artifact, 43 photographs (3 of which are Oversize (rolled) and remain in Box 1), 8 certificates are also present (7 of those are rolled and remain in Box 1).

**Note on Arrangement**: The notes on cards were made by Lurleen's daughter, Merle Webb, using clippings, College Registers and Normal School publications. The collection was transferred to the University of Regina Archives and Special Collections by Merle Webb.

Future Accruals: Future accruals are not expected.

Access Restrictions: There are no access restrictions.

**Legal Agreement**: The legal agreement was signed on July 27, 2009.
