PAMELA WALLIN

Biographical Sketch:

Pamela Wallin was born in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan and raised in Wadena, Saskatchewan. After graduating from Moose Jaw's Central Collegiate Institute, she attended the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus where she received a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology and Political Science. Following graduation Wallin worked as a social worker at the Prince Albert Penitentiary.

In 1972 Wallin co-hosted a noon-hour, open-line show on CBC Radio in Regina. Wallin spent six years working for CBC Radio in Regina, Ottawa, and Toronto on such programs as "As it Happens" and "Sunday Morning". In 1978 she joined the *Toronto Star* working for the Ottawa bureau. From 1981 to 1984 Wallin co-hosted CTV's "Canada AM". In 1985, she was hired by CTV as the Bureau Chief, making her the first woman in Canadian TV broadcast history to be appointed to this position. In 1992 she became co-host of CBC's "Prime Time News" with Peter Mansbridge. She was released from "Prime Time News" in April 1995, but returned to CBC in the following fall, hosting "Pamela Wallin Live" on CBC Newsworld, a program that was co-produced by her own production company, Current Affairs Groups Ltd.

By 2002 she had received numerous honorary degrees from various institutions, including a Doctorate of Laws from the University of Regina, a Doctorate of Letters from St. Thomas University, a Doctorate of Laws from Western University, a Doctorate of Journalism from Ryerson Polytechnic University, a Doctorate of Letters from Wilfrid Laurier University, and an honorary degree from Loyalist College. In 1999 Wallin was honoured with the Saskatchewan Order of Merit, and in 2008 she was invested into the Order of Canada as an officer, the second highest ranking offered.

Wallin was appointed by Jean Chretien as the Consul General in New York City in 2002. In this position Wallin lived and worked in New York until 2006. In December 2008, Wallin was appointed to the Senate of Canada where she is representative of Saskatchewan and serves on multiple committees.

Scope and content:

This collection consists of 47 Betacam tapes containing footage of Pamela Wallin's TalkTV program and .06m of records consisting of correspondence, 93 photographs, newspaper clippings dating 1982 to 2008 and magazines featuring Wallin.

Custodial History:

The donor retained the material before it was donated to the archives.

Future Accruals:

Future accruals are expected.

Legal Agreement and Access Restrictions: There are no access restrictions in this collection. The legal agreement was signed on March 6, 2009. The donor retains copy right as defined by the Copyright Act on materials created by her or her production company. Copyright remains with CBC and CTV where applicable.
