By ELIZABETH SEITZ AND CAITLIN MULLAN OCTOBER 2010 **Biographical Sketch:** Myrtle Vivian (Gryde) Rooney, known as 'Myrt' to her friends, was a student at Regina College during the school years 1931-1932 and 1932-1933.

'Myrt' was active in various school programs; she wore the College "R" for athletics and was on the school's Athletic Committee. In 1931-1932 Myrtle won First Prize in Religious Education and the Girls Senior First Prize in Athletics, she was runner up for the college tennis tournament in 1932, and won the tournament in June 1933, Myrtle also won an archery badge and the First Prize in General Proficiency in 1933. She was on the Senior Girl's Basketball Team in 1932 and in 1933 and she also enjoyed dancing, taking part as a "Folk Dancer" and "Country Dancer". She sang in the school Glee Club which was instructed by Mr. Wagg, and in 1932, with students from Regina College, Luther College, Campion College and the Normal School, Myrtle took part in the Operetta "The Pied Piper of Hamelin" singing with an alto voice.

Myrtle Rooney passed away in Edmonton, Alberta in 2004.

Scope and Content: The material in this collection arrived in a 1¼ inch binder containing handwritten notes, clippings, 12 artifacts, 65 photographs, and one publication. Among this material is one 1933 correspondence between Myrtle Gryde and Florence Kirk, who was an instructor at Regina College from 1930-1932. Also included are programs from various dances and commencement exercises, time table cards, college crests and pins. The sixty-five candid photographs offer a glimpse into the life of a female student in residence at Regina College 1930's. The date range of this collection is 1931 to 1965, predominantly 1931 to 1933.

Custodial History: This collection was transferred to the University of Regina in by Myrtle's younger brother Kenneth in October 2010.

Legal Agreement: A donation agreement was signed with Kenneth Rooney on October 29, 2010.

Access Restrictions: There are no access restrictions to the records.

Future Accruals: Future accruals are not expected.

Note on Arrangement: The pages of the binder have been photocopied and numbered for preservation purposes, including the outside and inside cover. The binder was then dismantled to preserve the archival items from the effects of the acidic paper and plastic they were housed in. The individual items were placed in folders classified into five series: Artifacts, Clippings, Correspondence, Photographs and Publications. This collection is in very good condition.
