Biographical Sketch: Lorna Crozier was born in Swift Current, Saskatchewan in 1948. She graduated from W.A. Beatty Collegiate in Swift Current in 1966, studied at the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus (now the University of Regina), and obtained her Bachelor of Arts in 1969. She received a Master of Arts from the University of Alberta in 1980. In addition to her university education, she attended creative writing courses at the Saskatchewan Summer School of the Arts at Fort San (1974-1977), and took courses in Advanced Writing and Speech Writing from the Public Service Commission.

Crozier taught high school English in rural Saskatchewan from 1970 to 1973, and taught English at the University of Regina (1976), the University of Alberta (1978-1979), and the University of Saskatchewan (1986-1991). Since 1991, she has been associate professor in the Department of Writing at the University of Victoria. She has been writer-in-residence at the University of Toronto (1988, 1989-1990), Douglas College, British Columbia (1989), the University of Lethbridge (1987), and the Regina Public Library (1984-1985), among others.

Crozier has published numerous books of poetry and her poetry has been included in dozens of journals and magazines. Crozier's work has also been featured in numerous anthologies, and her poetry and writing have resulted in her winning many prizes, such as First Prize in the CBC Radio National Poetry Competition (1987), the Western Magazine Award for Nonfiction (1989), the Governor General's Award for Poetry (1992), the National Magazine Gold Medal for Poetry (1995), among others.

She has conducted many readings and has lectured widely in Canada and the United States, as well as England, the former Yugoslavia, France and Chile. She has been heavily involved in the writers profession, and has served on various juries and judging panels. Crozier currently resides outside of Victoria with her husband, poet Patrick Lane.

Scope and Content

This collection consists of 3 meters of textual records, 51 photographs, 19 audio tape, 8 numbered compact disks (one disk was blank and therefore not numbered, File 344), 14 oversize items, 3 video tapes (VHS format), 45 computer diskettes. Indexes are available for Photographs and Compact Disks.

The collection is divided into the following main series: Audio Visual Material, Correspondence, Personal, Photographs, Professional Activities, Publications, Publications by or featuring Lorna Crozier, Teaching Materials, Writing by Lorna Crozier, Writing by Others. The date range of the textual records is 1984 to 2010, with the predominant dates being 2006 to 2009.

Custodial History: The collection was transferred to Archives and Special Collections by the donor.

Legal Agreement: The legal agreement is pending.

Future Accruals: Future accruals are expected.

Access Restrictions: There are no access restrictions to the records in this collection however there are several Restricted files. These Restricted files are indicated in the finding aid and are open to researchers with prior permission from the Archivist.

Related Accessions: 86-67, 90-103, 92-23, 94-95, 97-45, 2002-56 and 2007-2.

Note on Arrangement: A filing system for the textual records at time was created by the Archives staff. Preservation photocopying was carried out where necessary, photographs were numbered and sleeved and the audio and video tapes as well as the compact disks were numbered.
