**Biographical Sketch:** James Napier McCrorie was born in Montreal in 1936. At McGill University Jim studied sociology and came to Saskatchewan to work with the Saskatchewan Farmers Union. He completed a Ph.D. degree through University of the Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 1964 and the next year he joined the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus.

Social activism and teaching were important issues to Jim, issues such as North Sea oil development, Scotland's Roderick MacFarquar, rural development and sustainability. The Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion, a part of the International Brigades involved in Spain's Civil War 1936 to 1939, and the 1935 On-to-Ottawa Trek were also of special interest to McCrorie. He is among those who assisted Canadians in the International Brigades, Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion (named for William Lyon Mackenzie and Louis-Joseph Papineau, leaders of the 1837 Rebellions that took place in Lower and Upper Canada in 1837 and 1838) in their quest to become recognized officially by the Canadian Government and the people of Canada for their bravery in volunteering during 1936 to 1939 by helping to save Spain and its people from fascist, General Francisco Franco, and from the armies of Hitler's Nazi Germany and the fascist Italian President, Benito Mussolini who supported Franco.

At the time the Canadian Government, practicing "Non-intervention" in Spain's civil war, made it illegal for any fascist-fighters to go to Spain, although many went regardless. They posed as tourists travelling to Paris for the 1937 World's Fair and from there took a dangerous trek over Spain's Pyrenees Mountain range, took some training and moved on into the fighting.

The Books of Remembrance in The Tower of Victory and Peace in Canada's parliament building at Ottawa do not include the names of the fallen Canadians from Spain's Civil War. These men were not entitled to veteran's benefits nor are they among those usually remembered on the day set aside to commemorate and remember *all* of Canada's fallen soldiers.

With 60 years of perseverance monuments in Canada to the Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion have been erected in Victoria, British Columbia, and in 2001 a national monument was erected in Ottawa. In September 2013, the last surviving member of the Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion died, Jules Paivio was 97.

McCrorie became Director of the Canadian Plains Research Center in the 1980's and retired in 1996. He passed away in 2013 and was the author of, or contributed to, the following publications:

**Scope and Content:** These papers were collected by William (Bill) Beeching, a veteran of the 15th International Brigade Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion who was commissioned by the Veterans of the Mackenzie Papineau Battalion to research and write the history of the Canadian volunteers who fought for Spain against the anti-fascist regime. The collection contains interview tapes and transcripts,

research documents including stories contributed by individual members of the 'Mac-Pap' Battalion and copies of censured Royal Canadian Mounted Police files. This material resulted in the publication of *Canadian Volunteers Spain 1936-1939*. The book is a collection of the veterans' recollections of their experiences, published by the Canadian Plains Research Centre of the University of Regina in 1989. This collection contains: 3 Artifacts; 99 Audio Cassettes; 2 Audio Cassettes (mini); 1 Film; 3 Negative Strips; 403 Photographs; 7 Magnetic Tapes; 8 Slides; 1 Video Cassette Tape, (U matic) and 2 Video Cassette Tapes (VHS)

**Legal Agreement and Access Restrictions:** These papers were in the possession of Elaine McCrorie until their deposit with the Archives in 2014. A donor agreement is pending. There are no access restrictions to the records in this collection although a small number of files are 'Closed.'
