Biographical Sketch:

Myrna Ann Kostash was born in Edmonton, Alberta in 1944. She attended the University of Alberta, receiving a Bachelor of Arts in 1965, majoring in Russian and French literature. After a further year of study at the University of Washington in Seattle she began work on her Master of Arts at the University of Toronto. She graduated with this degree in 1968.

Myrna Kostash is an investigative journalist and writer of regional and national acclaim. Kostash is the author of numerous books. Her articles and short stories have appeared in several anthologies, and extensively in periodicals such as *Chatelaine*, *Maclean's*, *Saturday Night*, and *Canadian Forum*. She has contributed radio, television, and film scripts to the CBC and the National Film Board, and has written stage plays. She has lectured widely in Canada and has taught courses, workshops, and seminars across the country. Myrna Kostash has been heavily involved with a number of professional organizations, serving on the executive of the Writers Union of Canada, the Periodical Writers of Canada, and the Alberta Writers Guild. She was on the Board of Directors of NeWest Press from 1982 to 1989. She was named Max Bell Professor of Journalism at the University of Regina for 1989 and 1990, and received the Alberta Achievement Award in 1989. Myrna Kostash resides in Edmonton.
