This collection is comprised of two series of 45 computer floppy disks: Macintosh and Windows. These disks belonged to Nick Russell. The disks, run on a Macintosh computer and/or on a Windows platform, are included, several of the disks have files which are no longer able to be opened or printed, any files which could be opened and printed were printed out, in several cases the files were printed from both the Macintosh and Windows files (Disks 1, 4, 5, 11, 12). This collection of disks was in use between 1993 and 1997.

Disk 5 – Files Printed in **Windows (File 7)** and **Macintosh (File 21)**, Additional Information: LABEL: Nix19 – Windows Install Files. Do not know which programs they are. TIFF files. Copied in Windows. Also Mac files (i.e. RESOURCE.FRK, FINDER.DAT). Copied in Macintosh.
