Biographical Sketch: John A. (Jack) Boan became a faculty member at the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus in 1962, and a full professor in 1969. Prior to 1962 he worked for the government in several capacities: as an economist with the federal government from 1949 to 1956; on the Defense Research Board from 1956 to 1960; in the Economics Division of the Department of Northern Affairs and Natural Resources from 1960 to 1961; and as a member of the Royal Commission on Health Research Staff from 1961 to 1963.

His service activities range widely from local concerns on the quality of television broadcasting to United Way and Miles for Millions fund-raising campaigns and yet further to issues of International Development. Indeed, he serves on so many committees and subcommittees that it becomes virtually impossible to discern what is purely voluntary community service and what is service that is also of professional interest to him. Perhaps he does not himself make that sort of distinction about his work. The sheer number of these activities indicates also, that he is the kind of person who is desired in committee work because, despite the sometimes pedestrian and uninteresting nature of this work, he gets it done effectively.

His dearest interest, at least as far as this collection indicates, is International Development and Resource management. His committee work in this area shows a desire to address the problems of both development and underdevelopment, problems about which, as an economist, he is mightily aware. Apparently firm in the conviction that education will redress some of the wrongs and inequities of these international situations, he has done much work for agencies which promote general education in underdeveloped regions of the world, and awareness about effective stewardship in the developed regions. To all of this can be added extensive participation in committees dealing with the administration of both his particular academic division and the University itself.

Scope and Content: This collection contains little of his teaching papers and virtually none of his private papers from his former career. It deals, rather, with all of his activities and involvements beyond his purely professional obligations. The man revealed to us in this collection is a highly energetic and committed man who acts on his convictions.

Access Restrictions: This private collection may contain university records that are subject to review before access may be granted. Access to University records is governed by the *Local Authority Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.*

Note on Arrangement: The files themselves remain intact (with some minor culling) as Professor Boan left them. The order of the files has been changed somewhat to distinguish local work from that of a more regional or national character, and to provide easy subject accessibility.
