This collection contains the personal papers of poet/writer Patrick Lane. A native of British Columbia, Lane was born in Nelson in 1939. After completing high school in Vernon, he went to work in the mines, mills, logging camps and farms of BC. In 1965, Lane moved to Vancouver where he began to publish with his own press called Very Stone House. Since then he has traveled throughout the world and eked out a living with his poetry and with the odd job. He has published almost twenty books of poetry, appeared in the major anthologies of Canadian and American poetry, won the Governor General's Award for Literature in 1978 (for Poems: New and Selected, Oxford University Press, 1978), received Senior Arts Awards from the Canada Council, and has been appointed Writer-in-Residence at universities, libraries and theatres across Canada. Lane's literary criticism has appeared In Canadian journals and has been broadcast on the CBC. Patrick Lane ranks among the most important poets in Canada.

The Patrick Lane papers give insights into a man of strong opinions whose life is poetry. The collection includes publications and writings of other authors, who often asked Lane for his advice on their work. It also contains an incomplete set of publications by Lane, some of his writings and poems, as well as sketchbooks, photographs, tapes and other files. The most important aspect of the papers are the correspondence files, including correspondence with family members, professional organizations, publishers and other writers and poets. The list of correspondents reads like a Canadian Who's Who of the literary world. The correspondence files, which include carbon copies of Lane's letters to others, reflect the craft of the creation of poetry in Canada, and are particularly valuable as a resource material on the emergence of the 1960s and 1970s generation of poets. The Patrick Lane papers generally cover the period 1976 - 84, when Lane moved from BC to the prairies.
